

HAPPY RUFFLED SOCK CUFF

Instructions for adding a cheery little ruffled and ribbed cuff to an anklet version of our Churchmouse Classics 'Basic Sock' pattern

Years ago Jaime Amador added a darling ruffle to a pair of simple socks. You might remember Jaime as the 'mouse' who often exclaimed, when wrapping up a customer's purchase, "That's a bag of happy!" Jaime now owns Classic Cycle, a splendid bike shop on Bainbridge Island, and we think these socks are just perfect for happy pedaling adventures.

Yarn:	Our sample used 220 yds/201m of fingering-weight sock yarn for a women's medium sock (9" foot length). We've used 1 skein Rowan <i>Fine Art</i> (437 yds/400m each).
Needles:	16 or 24" circular needle same size as gauge needle for socks (we used US $1\frac{1}{2}$.5mm).
	Please refer to the original pattern for complete sock instructions. Only changes are covered in this addendum.
Ruffled cuff:	Using 16 or 24" circular needle and cable cast-on method, cast on 256 sts. <u>Row 1</u> (RS): Without joining, K2Tog across row. (128 sts remain)
	<u>Round 1</u> : Join in round, being careful not to twist. K2Tog around (tugging a little after each K2Tog), and divide stitches onto three double-point needles: 20/20/24. (64 sts)
	<u>Round 2</u> : K2/P2 around. Repeat Round 2 until ribbing measures 2".
	Proceed to Step 2 for heel flap. Complete sock in stockinette stitch (knit every round) as directed.
Finishing:	Finish as original pattern, using cast-on tail to close small gap at beginning of ruffle.

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
