

'COLOR PLAY MOHAIR WRAP': 8 Color Version in *Kidsilk Haze*Instructions for making the wrap from your Churchmouse Classics 'Color Play Mohair Scarf & Wrap' pattern using eight colors of Rowan Kidsilk Haze.

Finished Size: Wrap: Approx. 18"/46cm wide x 80"/203cm long, after blocking.

Yarn: 8 skeins Rowan Kidsilk Haze (229 yds/209m each); one skein each in 8 colors.

Designate colors A–H. Tip: You can arrange colors with subtle shifting or more contrasting blocks. Our sample used colors A = 685 Laguna, B = 632 Hurricane, C = 708 Navy, D = 725

Verdant, E = 707 Hale, F = 724 Aegean, G = 721 Olive, H = 720 Apple.

Or approx. 229 yds/209m each in 8 colors of an equivalent lace-weight mohair yarn.

Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.

Only <u>changes</u> are covered in this adaptation. Read original instructions thoroughly.

Cast on: With one strand each of colors A <u>and</u> B, cast on as instructed in original pattern for <u>wrap</u>

(91 sts).

Wrap 8-Color Sequence:

Work Border and Body as instructed in original pattern using the following color sequence:

<u>Section 1</u>: A + B, until wrap measures approx. 9"/23cm from cast-on edge.

<u>Section 2</u>: B + C, until B runs out. Note: Remember that blocks will vary in length and you can

change color mid-row.

Section 3: C + D, until C runs out.

<u>Section 4</u>: D + E, until D runs out.

<u>Section 5</u>: E + F, until E runs out.

Section 6: F + G, until F runs out.

Section 7: G + H, until G runs out.

Section 8: H + A, until just enough of H and A remain to work 10 rows of seed stitch and

bind off (approx. 3g or 27 yds/25m of each yarn).

Finishing: Complete final border and block as instructed in original pattern.
