

CRAZY BIG MUFFLER

Quick, cozy and reversible! Four little pompoms grace each corner for added charm.

Finished Size: Approx. 6½ x 96"/16.5 x 244cm, after blocking.

Yarn: 3 skeins Wool and the Gang Crazy Sexy Wool (87 yds/80m each).

Or approx. 261 yds/240m super bulky-weight yarn.

Needles US 17 (12–12.75mm) needles, or size to obtain gauge.

& Notions: US 15 (10.0mm) needles, or one size smaller than gauge needle.

15/8"/45mm pompom maker; strong yarn or string to attach pompoms.

Large darning needle to finish.

Gauge: Approx. 11 sts = 4"/10cm in K1/P1 ribbing, unstretched.

Glossary: K = knit; P = purl; St(s) = stitch(es).

To reduce bulk, when changing to a new splice yarn whenever possible.

Pompoms: Before beginning, make four pompoms following instructions on pompom maker. After

cutting yarn, tie very firmly with strong string. Tie again using a split portion of the working yarn as follows: twist both ends tightly and allow to twist back on each other to make a sturdy yarn for attaching to muffler (alternatively, you can use a finer yarn in a

matching color). Set aside.

Cast on: With <u>smaller needles</u>, using cable cast-on method, cast on 18 sts.

Row 1: *K1, P1*; repeat between * * to end.

Repeat Row 1 once more.

K1/P1 ribbing: Change to gauge needles and repeat Row 1 until work measures 95"/241cm, or desired

length, making sure to leave approx. 7 yds/m for remaining rows and bind-off.

Note: Remaining rows will add approx. 1"/2.5cm.

Change to smaller needles and work 2 more rows in pattern.

Bind off firmly in pattern, matching tension of cast-on edge. Cut yarn; fasten off.

Finishing: To weave in ends, split tails into two strands and duplicate stitch each into a different row

to distribute extra bulk. Wet block if desired (this yarn is thick; allow plenty of time to dry).

Sew a pompom to each corner securely. Bury tails back into pompom; clip ends to hide.
