



**CROCHETED HEMP COASTERS AND TRIVETS**  
**Instructions for making coasters and trivets using your Churchmouse At Home**  
**'Crocheted Baskets' pattern.**

*For summer picnic tables or festive pops of color on sunny kitchen tables, we made simple crocheted coasters and trivets using our 'Crocheted Baskets' pattern. One skein of ultra-durable allhemp6 is enough for eight coasters, or two trivets, or four coasters and one trivet—your choice!*

- Finished Size:**      **Coaster:** Approx. 4" in diameter.  
                                 **Trivet:** Approx. 8" in diameter.
- Yarn:**                    One skein of Hemp for Knitting's *allhemp6* (165 yds/150m).  
                                 Or approx. 165 yds/150m of an equivalent DK-weight cotton or hemp yarn.  
                                 *Note: One 4" coaster takes approx. 20 yds and one 8" trivet takes approx. 80 yds.*
- Needles & Notions**    Size E (3.5mm) crochet hook, or size to obtain gauge (for a nice firm fabric).  
                                 Locking stitch marker.  
                                 Darning needle to weave in ends.

Only changes are covered in this adaptation.*

- Base:**                    For a coaster of approx. 4" in diameter, work 'Base' section of pattern through Round 10.  
                                 For a trivet of approx. 8" in diameter, work 'Base' section through Round 24.
- Finishing:**            Finish as written on pattern.
- Blocking:**            Steam press with hot iron, using a press cloth.
