

## EASY EYELET WRAP: Scarf Version Instructions for re-sizing your Churchmouse Classics 'Easy Eyelet Poncho & Wrap' in Madelinetosh Tosh Merino Light and ITO Sensai.

Finished Size:	Approx. 16 x 76"/40.5 x 193cm, after blocking; fringe adds approx. 4"/10cm per end.
Yarn:	2 skeins Madelinetosh <i>Tosh Merino Light</i> (420 yds/384m each) <u>and</u> 3 skeins ITO <i>Sensai</i> (262 yds/240m each) <u>held together</u> throughout. Or approx. 660 yds/600m <u>each</u> of an equivalent single-ply fingering-weight yarn and lace- weight mohair yarn <u>held together</u> .
Needles & Notions:	US 8 (5mm) needles, or size to obtain gauge.
Gauge:	Approx. 13 sts = 4"/10cm, with yarns <u>held together</u> after blocking. <i>Note: Row gauge is determined by your swatch, see page 2 of original pattern.</i>
	Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions. Only changes are covered in this adaptation.
Before beginning:	Make a swatch following DK-weight instructions on pattern to establish row gauge and then calculate total number of rows to work at your gauge.
Cut fringe:	Using <u>only</u> <i>Tosh Merino Light</i> , cut 312 pieces 10"/26cm long as directed in original pattern. Set aside.
Provisional cast-on:	With waste yarn cast on 53 sts as directed in original pattern. Holding a strand of each yarn throughout, continue working as directed in pattern repeating eyelet row to desired length from cast-on edge, ending with RS row.
	Continue working as directed in original pattern through second bind-off.

Attach fringe: Holding <u>three</u> strands of fringe together, attach fringe as directed in original pattern.

**Blocking:** Block as directed in original pattern to new dimensions.

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
