



## FISHERMAN'S RIB MUFFLER

*Choose your favorite soft, squishy yarn in DK, worsted, chunky or superchunky weight and knit a toasty warm scarf in this deeply textured rib.*

- Finished Size:** Approx. 7 x 68"/18 x 173cm.  
*Directions given for DK with worsted, chunky and superchunky weights in parentheses ().*
- Yarn:** Approx. 500 (438, 378, 228) yds/ 457 (400, 346, 208)m. Choose a yarn that typically knits at a gauge of about 22 (18-20, 14, 10) sts = 4"/10cm. *Note: For added width you may need more yarn.*
- Needles & Notions:** US 7 (9, 10½, 15)/4.5 (5.5, 6.5, 10)mm needles, or size to obtain gauge.  
Blunt darning needle to finish.
- Gauge range:** Approx. 16 (13, 11, 8) sts = 4"/10cm in stitch pattern.
- Glossary:** **K** = knit; **K1b** = knit 1 below (insert right needle from front to back into center of stitch below stitch on left needle; knit this stitch, allowing stitch on needle to drop off and making sure new stitch has caught both the stitch on the needle and the one below); **P** = purl; **St(s)** = stitch(es).
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- Cast on:** Using cable cast-on method, cast on 30 (28, 22, 14) sts. *Note: To increase or decrease width, add or subtract sts in multiples of 2.*  
Set-up row: K2, \*P1 K1\*; repeat between \* \* to last 2 sts, P2.  
Row 1: With yarn in back, slip first st purlwise, \*K1b, P1\*; repeat between \* \* to last st, P1.  
Repeat Row 1 until scarf measures approx. 68"/173cm, or to desired length.  
*Note: Join new ball of yarn a few stitches in from the edge.*  
Bind off loosely in pattern (slipping first st and working each st exactly as in Row 1).
- Finishing:** Weave in ends as invisibly as possible. Steam or wet block as desired.
