



‘LACE SAMPLER SCARF’: mYak *Baby Yak Lace* Version
Instructions for knitting a narrower version of the
‘Lace Sampler Scarf’ in mYak *Baby Yak Lace*.

- Finished Size:** Approx. 11 x 66"/28 x 168cm.
- Yarn:** 2 skeins mYak *Baby Yak Lace* (380 yds/350m each). Or approx. 670 yds/612m of an equivalent lace-weight yarn.
- Needles & Notions:** US 3 (3.25mm) needles, or size to give gauge. *Note: You may need a different needle size for each lace motif. See Swatching For Gauge on page 2 of pattern. While yak wool does not have the same tendency to bounce back as sheep wool, knitting a 35-st swatch as described in the instructions is recommended.*
2 stitch markers.
Darning needle to finish.
Blocking wires and T-pins.
- Gauge:** 22 sts/36 rows = 4"/10cm in each lace motif, after blocking and resting.

*Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation.*

- Cast on:** With gauge needle, using cable cast-on method, cast on 71 sts.
- Van Dyke Lace Section:** Work 90 total rows of Van Dyke Lace (15 repeats of the 6-row pattern).
- Diagonal Lace Section:** Work 434 total rows of Diagonal Lace (36 repeats of the 12-row pattern plus 2 more rows).
- English Mesh Lace Section:** Work 88 total rows of English Mesh Lace (11 repeats of the 8-row pattern).

Finish and block according to original pattern instructions.

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
