



MAGIC THREE-YARN 'RECIPE' CARD Handmaiden/Fleece Artist Throw

Yarns used: (We used two Magic Three-Yarn Wrap kits.)

A: 2 skeins Handmaiden Maiden Hair (328 yds/300m each).

B: 4 skeins Fleece Artist Slubby Blue. (110 yds/100m each).

C: 2 skeins Fleece Artist Curlylocks. (246 yds/225m each).

Needles: US 11 (8mm) 24-32" circular; US 15 (10mm) to bind off.

Gauge: Approx. 11 sts = 4"/10cm.

Size: Approx. 48" length (sts) x 44" width (rows), before fringing.

Cast on: 132 sts (gauge x desired length).

Fringe: At each end of every three rows, we placed two 14" pieces <u>each</u> of yarns A and C. We placed our clusters at the ends of Slubby Blue ridges.

Notes: We chose not to have Yarn B next to our bound-off edges, as its bulk distorted the edges a bit. So, we ended with a Row 1 (yarn A) and bound off with yarn C.

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When choosing your yarn sequence, decide which yarn you'd like at the long edges of your piece: this will be 'Yarn C'. If you're mixing yarns, do you want your edges smooth? fuzzy? textured? If you have three colors of the same yarn, what color do you want your edges to be? Also, consider which of your yarns has more yardage: you'll need more of 'Yarn C' as you'll use it to bind off both edges.
