



PICOT EDGE WASHCLOTH: *Creative Linen* Version
Instructions for regauging your Churchmouse Classics
'Picot-Edge Baby Blanket & Washcloth' pattern

The classic washcloth worked up in a dry, light plant fiber mix—perfect for kitchen, bath or baby!

- Finished size:** Picot-edge version: Approx. 10 x 10"/25.5 x 25.5cm, after blocking.
Plain-edge version: Approx. 8 x 8"/20 x 20cm, after blocking.
- Yarn:** 1 skein Rowan *Creative Linen* (219 yds/200m each). One skein yields two picot-edge washcloths or three plain-edge washcloths.
Or approx. 200 yds/183m in an equivalent DK-weight plant fiber yarn.
- Needles
& Notions:** US 5 (3.75mm) needles, or size to obtain gauge.
- Gauge:** 22 sts/44 rows = 4"/10cm in garter stitch, after blocking.

Only changes are covered in this adaptation.*

- Picot-edge
version:** Repeat Increase Rows 1–4 until 68 sts on needle, ending with Row 4.
- Plain-edge
version:** Repeat Increase Row until 58 sts on needle.
