

## SLOUCHY BASIC BEANIE: Rowan Softyak DK Version

If you need a slouchy hat for those in-between seasons, this is it! Cotton, soft downy yak, and a bit of nylon creates a soft and springy hat that's cool to wear, spring or fall.

Finished Size: Adult Medium (Adult Large): Approx. 18 (20)"/46 (51)cm around x 9½"/24cm deep.

Note: Hat will stretch to fit head 2-4"/5-10cm larger than finished circumference. To adjust size,

cast on a multiple of 5 sts.

Yarn: 2 skeins Rowan Softyak DK (148 yds/135m each).

Or approx. 296 yds/270m of an equivalent DK-weight yarn.

Needles US 7 (4.5mm) 16"/40cm circular and double-point needles, or size to obtain gauge.

& Notions: US 6 (4mm) 16"/40cm circular needle, or one size smaller than gauge needle.

5 stitch markers, 1 in a contrast color. Darning needle to finish.

**Gauge:** Approx. 22 sts = 4"/10cm in stockinette stitch, after blocking.

Glossary: K = knit; K2Tog = knit two stitches together; St(s) = stitch(es).

*Instructions given for Adult Medium size; Adult Large in parentheses ().* 

Cast-on: With smaller needle, cast on 100 (110) sts. Place contrast-color marker and join in the

round, being careful not to twist.

Knit every round, slipping marker, until work measures 1"/2.5cm from cast-on edge. Change to larger needle and knit every round until work measures approx. 7½"/19cm from

cast-on edge; on last round place 4 more markers every 20 (22) sts.

**Decrease rounds:** *Note: Change to double-point needles when necessary.* 

Round 1: \*Knit to 2 sts before marker, K2Tog\*; repeat between \* \* to end of round.

[5 sts decreased]
Round 2: Knit.

Repeat Round 1 only (decreasing every round) until 5 sts remain.

Finishing: Break yarn, leaving an 8"/20cm tail. With darning needle, thread tail through all 5 sts, one

at a time. Draw up tightly.

Weave in ends on wrong side. Wet or steam block gently, as desired.

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
