



**‘TWO-POINT COWL’: mYak Baby Yak Medium Version
Instructions for regauging your Churchmouse Classics
‘Two-Point Cowl’ in mYak Baby Yak Medium.**

- Yarn:** 4 skeins mYak *Baby Yak Medium* (125 yds/117m each).
Or approx. 500 yds/468m of an equivalent worsted-weight yarn.
- Needles
& Notions:** US 7 (4.5mm) 24"/60cm and 16"/40cm circular needle, or size to obtain gauge.
Spare 16"/40cm circular needle one size smaller than gauge needle.
- Gauge:** Approx. 19 sts/27 rows = 4"/10cm in stockinette stitch, after blocking.
Note: If your blocked gauge is slightly different, that's ok! Simply use our re-gauging worksheet to calculate stitches and rows for your blocked gauge.

*Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation. Read original instructions thoroughly.*

- Cast on shoulder section:** Cast on 69 sts as directed in original pattern.
- Neck opening rows:** Work as directed in original pattern, repeating Rows 1 and 2 as directed in original pattern until piece measures 22"/56cm. [148 rows]
- Joining sides of shoulder section:** Working as directed in original pattern, pick up live stitches. Make sure you have 69 sts on your needle.
Work Joining row as directed. [138 sts]
Continue working as directed, until piece measures 7"/18cm from joining row. [47 rows]
Bind off shoulder section as directed in original pattern.
- Pick up for cowl collar:** Working as directed in original pattern, pick up and knit 100 sts evenly spaced around neck opening.
Continue working as directed, until collar measures 7"/19cm or desired length, making sure you have at least 8 yds/m for binding off. [47 rounds]
Bind off as directed in original pattern.

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
