

WOOLLY WREATH & GARLAND: Manos Maxima Version Instructions for adapting your Churchmouse At Home 'Woolly Wreath & Garland' pattern.

Our original woolly wreaths and garlands were knitted in a bulky-weight yarn. This year we knitted the Small Wreath and Garland in a soft, single-ply worsted-weight yarn, and loved the result! Here is how we did it.

Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.

Only changes are covered in this adaptation.

Small wreath: 2 skeins Manos Maxima (219 yds/200m each) held double throughout.

Or approx. 280 yds/256m total of an equivalent worsted-weight yarn held double throughout.

Work loop stitch until piece is long enough to wrap around circumference of wreath form about one-and-a-half times. As you whip-stitch inner edges together around form,

scrunch work up to make it cover the form densely.

Garland: 1 skein Manos Maxima (219 yds/200m) held double throughout.

Or approx. 219 yds/200m total of an equivalent worsted-weight yarn <u>held double throughout</u>. Note: To hold yarn double when working from one skein, wind into a center-pull ball and use one end from inside and one end from outside held together. Or wind yarn into two balls of equal weight and use

one end from each held together.

Work as directed in pattern but hold yarn double throughout.
