



WOOLLY WREATH ORNAMENT

Instructions for adapting your Churchmouse at Home 'Woolly Wreath & Garland' pattern.

Years ago we knitted mammoth woolly wreaths for our shop holiday display and they were so popular that we created home-sized versions for a cozy accent. Now we're taking cozy to the next level with a wee Woolly Wreath Ornament!

Finished Size: Approx. 4½"/11cm circumference.

Yarn: 1 skein Brown Sheep *Lamb's Pride* Worsted (190 yds/174m) held double throughout.
Note: 1 skein should yield three ornaments.
Or approx. 190 yds/174m total of an equivalent worsted-weight yarn held double throughout.
Or approx. 95 yds/87m total of an equivalent bulky-weight yarn held single.

Needles & Notions: US 8 (5mm) needle.
Three 3" embroidery hoops.
1 yard of yarn, twine or ribbon for three 12" hanging loops.
Darning needle to finish.

Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation.

Cast on: Cast on 7 stitches loosely using double strand of worsted-weight yarn.

Loop stitch: Continue with double strand. Work Rows 1 and 2 of loop stitch 24 times (48 rows total) or until strip is long enough to wrap around wreath form, being sure to reserve a long enough tail to end with Row 1, bind off, and seam. Bind off loosely.

Finishing: No muslin wrap is necessary. Follow instructions for seaming on pattern.

Attach hanging loop through hoop screw.

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
