



‘SLOUCHY PULLOVER’: Cropped Version
Instructions for a cropped length and shorter sleeve version of
Churchmouse Classics ‘Slouchy Pullover’ in Rowan Kidsilk Haze.

Finished bust: 40 (46, 52, 58)"/102 (117, 132, 147)cm, after seaming and blocking.
To fit bust: 28–32 (34–38, 40–44, 46–50)"/71–81 (86–96, 102–112, 117–127)cm.
With ease of: Approx. 8–12"/20–30.5cm.
Finished length: Approx. 18 (18, 19, 19)"/20 (20, 22, 22)cm from high shoulder to hem.

Yarn: 4 (4, 5, 5) skeins Rowan *Kidsilk Haze* (229yds/210m each).
Or approx. 820 (916, 990, 1080) yds/750 (838, 905, 988)m of an equivalent lace-weight silk mohair yarn, held double-stranded throughout (not quadruple-stranded as in original pattern).

Needles

& Notions: US 15 (10mm) needles, or size to obtain gauge.
US 11 (8mm) needles, or two sizes smaller than gauge needle for picking up sleeve sts.
12 locking stitch markers.
Darning needle to finish.

Gauge:

8 sts/13 rows = 4"/10cm in stockinette stitch on larger needle, after blocking.

Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation. Read original instructions thoroughly.

Cast on:

Use 2 strands (not 4 as in original pattern).

Cropped version:

Beginning with knit row, work 22 rows in St St, or number of rows required to achieve 7"/18cm or desired length, to armhole at your blocked row gauge, ending with a purl row.
Note: Armhole and shoulder shaping will add approx. 11"/28cm to overall length, measured from high shoulder (where shoulder meets neck) to hem.

Shorter sleeves

version: Omit cuff shaping rows; bind off on RS.
