

KNITTER'S PROJECT NOTES

Churchmouse Classics 'Oxford Socks' in Regia Premium Merino Yak; details for additional foot and cuff variations.

Using three skeins, we were able to make three pairs of socks with varying color combinations and cuff lengths and still have enough left over for a fourth pair. Use our notes or let your personality show with your own unique combinations!

Yarn: 2-Color Stockinette Version: 2 skeins Regia Premium Merino Yak (437 yds/400m each); 1

skein <u>each</u> in Colors A and B.

3-Color Stockinette Version: 3 skeins Regia Premium Merino Yak (437 yds/400m each); 1

skein each in Colors A, B, and C.

For our samples, we used Color A = 7510 Beige Meliert, Color B = 7523 Jeans Meliert, and Color C = 7516 Gras Green Meliert. Note: Our 2-color ribbed version was worked as directed in

original pattern.

Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions. Only project specific details are covered in these notes.

2-Color Version

Both Socks: With Color A work toe and heel.

With Color B work foot in stockinette stitch.

Continuing with Color B, work cuff in stockinette stitch for 3"/7.5cm, then work in K2/P2

ribbing for 1"/2.5cm.

3-Color Version

First Sock: With Color A work toe.

With Color B work foot in stockinette stitch.

With Color C work heel.

Continuing with Color B, work cuff in stockinette stitch for 6"/15cm.

Change to Color A and work in K2/P2 ribbing for 1"/2.5cm.

Second Sock: With Color C work toe.

With Color A work foot in stockinette stitch.

With Color B work heel.

Continuing with Color A, work cuff in stockinette stitch for 6"/15cm.

Change to Color C and work in K2/P2 ribbing for 1"/2.5cm.

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
