



**‘SIMPLE TOE-UP SOCK’: The Fibre Co. *Amble* Version**  
**Knitter’s Notes for re-yarning your Churchmouse Classics**  
**‘Simple Toe-Up Sock’ in The Fibre Co. *Amble*.**

**Finished Size:** Medium-width adult: Up to 10"/25cm foot on 7"/18cm cuff. For a longer foot, knit a shorter cuff—or purchase more yarn.

**Yarn:** 2 skeins The Fibre Co. *Amble* (355 yds/325m each); 1 each in Main Color (MC) and Contrasting Color (CC). For our sample, we used MC = Blencathra and CC = Appleby Castle.  
Or approx. 355 yds/325m in MC for foot and cuff and approx. 85 yds/78m in CC for toe, heel, and cuff stripe.

Only project specific details are covered in these notes.*

For this version, we followed Foot & Cuff Variation B (stockinette stitch foot with ribbed cuff) as directed on the original pattern (page 2) using CC for toe and heel and MC for foot and cuff.

We added a 3 round stripe of CC at the top of the cuff as follows:

Work cuff as directed until approx. 1"/2.5cm less than desired finished length. Change to CC and work 3 rounds in K2/P2 ribbing as established. Change to MC and continue in ribbing until desired length.
